



30 DAYS OF PRAYER FOR LDS PEOPLE

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As Christians, while we know that The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS) is a false church and a cult, it is still comprised of people whom Jesus created, loves, and died for. For this reason, we—the true church of the true Jesus Christ—must pray for their souls. This is a battle that will not be won by argument or apologetics, but by prayer. After all, this is a spiritual fight, not an intellectual one. Because the LDS church is rooted in Freemasonry and the occult, it remains a spiritual struggle.

This *30 Days of Prayer for the LDS* is a guide to pray for the breaking of LDS beliefs and the opening of their eyes to the true Lord Jesus Christ. Each day focuses on a different aspect of prayer for the LDS people.

Before you begin your daily prayers, start by praying for your own spiritual covering and protection. You can pray:

“Lord Jesus Christ, I come before You today to lift up the LDS people, whom You love and died to save. As I pray, I ask the Holy Spirit to cover me with a hedge of protection from demonic attacks. Please open my ears to hear Your voice and lead me in what You want me to pray in addition to today’s topic. Amen!”

Day 1: Pray that deceptions will be unveiled and the truths of the Gospel will be confirmed.

Day 2: Pray for the removal of confusion through the illumination of the Holy Spirit.

Day 3: Pray that LDS people will gain the courage to ask tough questions and refuse to settle for typical LDS "pat answers."

Day 4: Pray that LDS people will recognize their deep need for God's intervention in their lives and look to Him for answers.

Day 5: Pray for the dismantling of the LDS understanding of key crossover terms and for the formation of a true Christian understanding.

Day 6: Pray for the exposure of false teachings and lies within the Book of Mormon and other LDS writings. Pray that the LDS people will discover the deceptions within the LDS cult and reject all faulty rationalizations.

Day 7: Pray that the LDS people will investigate LDS history and teachings and be moved to seek the truth.

Day 8: Pray for the exposure of demonic and Satanic roots at the highest levels of the LDS cult.

Day 9: Pray that the LDS people will recognize the demonic influence over the LDS cult.

Day 10: Pray that the demons within the LDS people will be paralyzed as they read the Bible.

Day 11: Pray that the LDS people would be turned away from the Book of Mormon and instead develop a deep hunger for the truth of the Bible.

Day 12: Pray that the truth of God's Word would pierce the hearts of the LDS people.

Day 13: Pray that the LDS people would understand the difference between the "Mormon Jesus" and the true Jesus of the Bible.

Day 14: Pray that the LDS people would hunger for the truth and not rest until they come to know Jesus.

Day 15: Pray that the LDS people would quiet their hearts so that they may hear God's voice and be deaf to the voices of demons.

Day 16: Pray that the LDS people will have a genuine encounter with the true Lord Jesus Christ.

Day 17: Pray that the LDS people would be able to observe the presence of God as revealed through His people.

Day 18: Pray that the LDS people would bring their questions and doubts to someone who will show them God's truth.

Day 19: Pray that the LDS people would understand the witness of God's people as seeds are planted through spoken words, music, and media.

Day 20: Pray that the LDS people would believe in the one true God.

Day 21: Pray that the LDS people would embrace the truth that God loves them and can forgive any sin.

Day 22: Pray that the LDS people would understand salvation by grace and not by works.

Day 23: Pray that the LDS people would fix their eyes on Jesus, rather than on the LDS cult.

Day 24: Pray that the LDS people would respond to the conviction of the Holy Spirit, call upon the name of the Lord Jesus, repent of their sins and false beliefs, and accept Jesus' free gift of salvation.

Day 25: Pray that former LDS people would know the peace that comes from a genuine relationship with God.

Day 26: Pray that former LDS people would be surrounded by Christian friends and a biblical community.

Day 27: Pray for the healing of former LDS people as they navigate the loss of LDS relationships and family connections.

Day 28: Pray for former LDS people as they adjust to their new beliefs and a true understanding of God.

Day 29: Pray for former LDS people to be disciplined and to grow in Christian faith and spiritual maturity.

Day 30: Pray for the Christian witness of former LDS people as they reach out to those still within the LDS church.

Prayer is the most powerful weapon we possess in the spiritual battle for souls. By completing these thirty days of prayer, you have stood in the gap for those still bound by the deceptions of the LDS cult. But your intercession does not have to end here.

Continue to remain sensitive to the Holy Spirit's prompting and keep your heart open to those the Lord places in your path. We trust that God is faithful to His Word, that He hears our cries, and that He is even now moving to unveil eyes and soften hearts. May we continue to pray without ceasing until every soul knows the freedom and grace of the true Lord Jesus Christ.
