Policy of the Council of Elders New Life Christian Community

Pastoral Relations Pastoral Standing

Policy Number: PAR-04

Date of Adoption: Oct 24, 2024

Statement of Provision (including scriptural support)

Since the Pastor is an Elder and a part of the Council of Elders we recognize that the Pastor must have the correct standing among the Elders and Church as a whole. Accordingly:

- 1. The Pastor is not an employee of the church and as such shall not be treated as an employee.
- 2. No one elder has authority over the Pastor. The Pastor is an equal amongst the Council of Elders and shall be treated as such.
- 3. The Pastor shall not be removed from his role for any reason other than listed in policy GOV-14 and has gone through the biblical process of Matthew 18. Should the Pastor be removed from his role, the Pastor Removal Policy (PAR-08) shall be followed.
- 4. The Pastor shall be fairly compensated for his work of the ministry as per policy PAR-05 (1 Cor 9:14; 1 Tim 5:17-18).
- 5. The Pastor is responsible for reporting his own income tax with integrity. It is recommended that the pastor seeks the expertise of an accountant.
